Please do not drop your child off before 8:10 a.m.

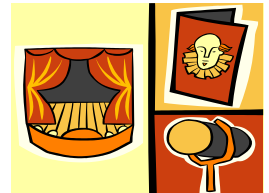
There is no supervision and the doors to school do not open before this time.
